

Training Sessions: Self-Sufficiency Matrix

Minnesota Housing and the Department of Human Services will require the Self-Sufficiency Matrix Assessment tool for all Long-term Homeless (LTH) programs and the Family Homelessness Prevention and Assistance Program (FHPAP) effective July 1, 2011. Program managers and supportive service staff should attend the trainings, which will focus on the implementation of the Self-Sufficiency Matrix Assessment tool. Participants will learn how to plan for the process, how to use the tool in interviews with clients, and how to use the information to analyze and advocate for their program.
