Coming this summer: Homeless service use in Minnesota: federal fiscal year 2009

Last year, Wilder released its first homeless service use report using data from each Continuum of Care region across Minnesota. This report documents the use of emergency shelters and transitional housing programs across the state and is based on data submitted to HUD for the Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR).

This summer, Wilder will publish the second Homeless service use in Minnesota report. The report will likely include additional information on veterans served across the state by emergency shelter and transitional housing programs.
