

## Benefits “Cheat Sheet”\*

If you receive **General Assistance (GA)**, you may also qualify for...

- Help with buying food through **Food Support**
- Health care through **General Assistance Medical Care (GAMC)**
- Housing through **Group Residential Housing (GRH)**
- Help with paying for emergency housing or utility bills through **Emergency General Assistance**
- Income support through **SSI or SSDI**

If you are on **Medicaid/Medical Assistance**, you may also qualify for...

- Income support through **SSI or SSDI or MFIP (TANF )**
- Supportive services through **medical waivers**, such as Adult Rehabilitative Mental Health Services (ARMHS) or Community Alternatives for Disabled Individuals (CADI)

If you are on **MFIP (TANF)**, you may also qualify for...

- Help with buying food through **Food Support**
- Health care through **Medicaid/Medical Assistance**
- Help with paying for emergency housing or utility bills through **Emergency General Assistance**

If you receive **Supplemental Security Income (SSI)** for a disability, you may also qualify for...

- Help with buying food through **Food Support**
- Health care through **Medicaid/Medical Assistance**
- Additional income through **Minnesota Supplemental Aid (MSA)**
- Housing through **Group Residential Housing (GRH)**
- Help with paying for emergency housing or utility bills through **Emergency Minnesota Supplemental Aid (EMSA)**

If you are on **Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI/RSDI)** or another **Social Security** program, you may also qualify for...

- Help with buying food through **Food Support**
- Health care through **Medicaid/Medical Assistance** or **Medicare**
- Housing through **Group Residential Housing (GRH)**

Help with paying for emergency housing or utility bills through **Emergency General Assistance (EGA)**
