

ART updates for fiscal year 2010 – 2011

We have started updating ART reports to conform to the changes made to HUD and Minnesota state funder assessments in June. Following is a list of the changes that have been made to the data elements in those reports.

1. DHS Youth: the demographic counting and data checks have been updated

a. DHS Youth Demographics Counting_V1011.1

1. A new tab (“All Clients”) has been added that will show the elements required of all clients: “Housing Status at Entry” and “Does client have a disability of long duration?”
2. On the Exit tab, a new table has been added to show “Housing Status at Exit”

Note that we also tried to improve formatting and pagination where possible; some tables may have moved to a new page to avoid poor page breaks.

b. DHS Youth Demographics Data Check_V1011.1

1. A new tab (“All Clients”) has been added that will show what has been entered into ServicePoint for “Housing Status at Entry” and “Does client have a disability of long duration?” Note that responses for the disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later.

2. ESGP: the counting and data check have both been updated

a. ESGP Counting Report_V1011.1

1. On the tab, “Table X-Subpopulations, the Disability Type counting table has been modified to include only disabilities that have “Yes” for Disability Determination
2. A new tab (“XII”) has been added that will show the elements required of all clients: “Housing Status at Entry” and “Does client have a disability of long duration?”

Note that we also tried to improve formatting and pagination where possible; some tables may have moved to a new page to avoid poor page breaks.

c. ESGP Data Check Report_V1011.1

1. On the tab, Table X-Subpopulations, a column has been added to the Disabilities table to show you what has been entered for “Disability Determination”. Disabilities will be included in the counting report only if Disability Determination = Yes.
2. A new tab (“XII-Assessment”) has been added that will show what has been entered into ServicePoint for “Housing Status at Entry” and “Does client have a disability of long duration?” Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later.

3. ESP: the counting and data check have both been updated

a. ESP Demographics & Services_V.1011.2

1. A new tab ("Assessment data - All") has been added that will show counting tables for "Housing Status at Entry" and "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later.

b. ESP Demographics Data Check_V.1011.1

1. A new tab ("Assessment data - All") has been added that will show what has been entered into ServicePoint for "Housing Status at Entry" and "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later

4. FHPAP: Demographics and Exit reports have been updated. (Both counting and data checks)
In addition, the Income reports will be updated before the next report period, but these changes have not been completed yet. The reports in the folder are accurate for basic data checking, but plan on do a final check on income after we've posted a report for Fiscal Year 2010 – 2011.

a. FHPAP Demographics and Entry Counts_V.1011.1

1. The "Disability Type" table has been removed; FHPAP no longer requires this
2. A new tab ("Assessment data - All") has been added that will show counting tables for "Housing Status at Entry" and "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later.

b. FHPAP Demographics and Entry Data Check_V.1011.2

1. The Disability Type data check table has been removed; it is no longer needed.
2. A new tab ("Assessment data - All") has been added that will show what has been entered into ServicePoint for "Housing Status at Entry" and "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later

c. FHPAP Exit Counts_V.1011.1

1. Reason for Leaving has been removed; all tables using this field have also been removed.
2. A table for "Housing Status at Exit" has been added.

d. FHPAP Exits Data Check_V.1011.1

1. Reason for Leaving has been removed; all tables using this field have also been removed.
2. "Housing Status at Exit" has been added to the "Destination-% income on rent" tab.

5. LTH: Demographics and Exit reports (Both counting and data checks)

In addition, the Income, Residence and Housing Cost & Subsidy reports will be updated before the next report period, but these changes have not been completed yet. The reports in the folder are accurate for basic data checking, but plan on do a final check after we've posted these reports for Fiscal Year 2010 – 2011.

a. LTH Demographics and Entry Counts_V.1011.2

1. Disabilities tab: a new table has been added for dual disabilities. The original table for Mental Health Problems + Substance Abuse remain on the report. In addition, there is now a table that shows clients with both alcohol abuse and chemical dependency.
2. A new tab ("Assessment data - All") has been added that will show counting tables for "Housing Status at Entry" and "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later.

b. LTH Demographics and Data Check_V.1011.2

1. Disabilities tab: a new tab has been added for dual disabilities. This table will show if the client has dual disability, and which form. The first column, "Dual" will show clients with Mental Health Problems and Chemical Dependency. The second column, "Both" will show clients with both alcohol and drug abuse.
2. A new tab ("Housing Status – all clients") has been added that will show what has been entered into ServicePoint for "Housing Status at Entry". Housing Status at Entry is required for all clients who entered June 10, 2010 or later. The last column on the table shows if Housing Status is required for this client
3. A separate tab (Disability Status – all clients) was added to show what has been entered for "Does client have a disability of long duration?" Note that responses for the Disability question have always been required for adults, but is only required for minors who entered June 1, 2010 or later. A column has been added to the column ("Disability Required?") which will note if the data needs to be added.

c. LTH Exits_V.1011.1

1. Exit Data tab: Removed "Reasons Leaving" table and added "Housing Status at Exit" table
2. The "Destinations" tab was removed because all of the tables on the page used "Reason Leaving", which is no longer required.
3. Client Exit data table: Removed "Reasons Leaving" and added "Housing Status at Exit".

d. LTH Exits Data Check_V.1011.1

1. Exit Data tab: Removed "Reasons Leaving" and added "Housing Status at Exit".
