## General Data check Table - Subsidy Information

Only Household Heads and singles who participated in the program during the report period are listed. This table shows all of the subsidy information for each Household Head during the report period.

When an individual has multiple subsidy sources listed, make sure that any subsidies that have ended have end dates on them. All subsidies listed without end dates will be included in the calculations, using the Report End Date to calculate Length of Subsidy. The column labelled "# of Separate Subsidies Recorded" will usually show 1. When a higher number is given, this means that there is more than 1 subsidy recorded for the same subsidy start date. Check to make sure that the subsidies recorded are not duplicated. If you have duplicated subsidies, delete the duplicates in ServicePoint, wait a day and run the report again.

If there is more than 1 type of subsidy listed under "Subsidy Source", a Length of Subsidy will be calculated for each Source. If the subsidies do not have the same Start and End date, they should not be recorded together. You should then make a new instance of the Housing Cost & Subsidy subassessment.
