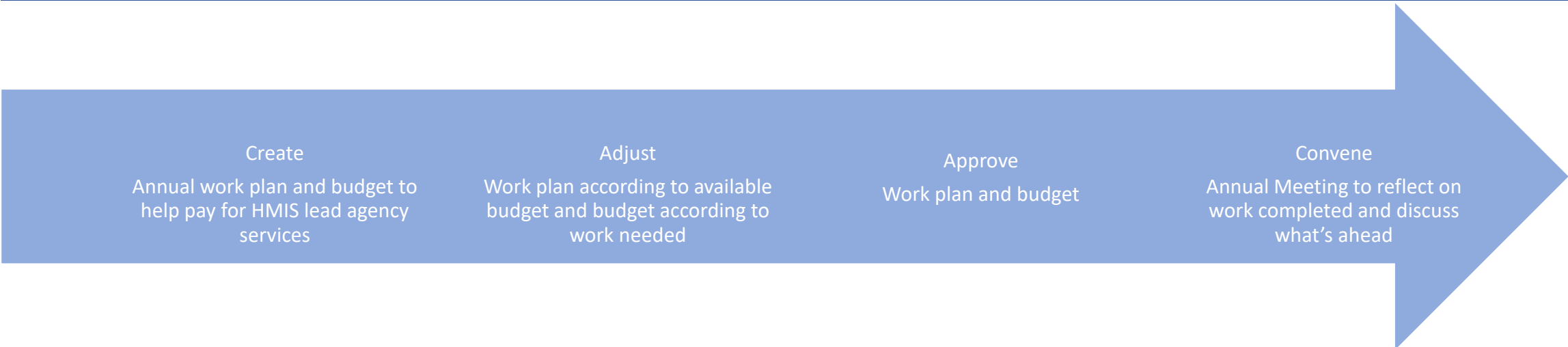




## WHAT WE DO

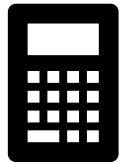
- Provide strategic planning, policies, and priorities for the administration of the HMIS program.

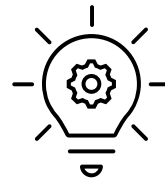
